Before we set a proper translation, here is a little explanatory note about the text content.

3 main moments of spoken language

1. Introduction

When the audience has arrived:

To start I would like to say three things:

- My real name is Claire but for tonight let's say it's Jeanne.

My shyness was sometimes taken for arrogance and I was ok with it.

But someone told me that for him it looked more like a lack of generosity: Because you can tell when everyone is speaking around a table and I don't say anything, that I do think something but I don't share it. And probably this remark had an impact on me.

- More recently, I've been watching some of my friends, I've been watching them quite well, and now I'm trying to do what they do, to copy them in a way. And I tell myself that I could have been like them, or even different. ... So let's go.

Interaction with audience, about 10 minutes (alternated with movements): The text is partly improvised. Content could go like:

3. Closure text

Announcing I'd like to share one more thing, which is a text:

We now place our courage in "doing as our friends do" and "maintaining our standards". and when we are being open,
